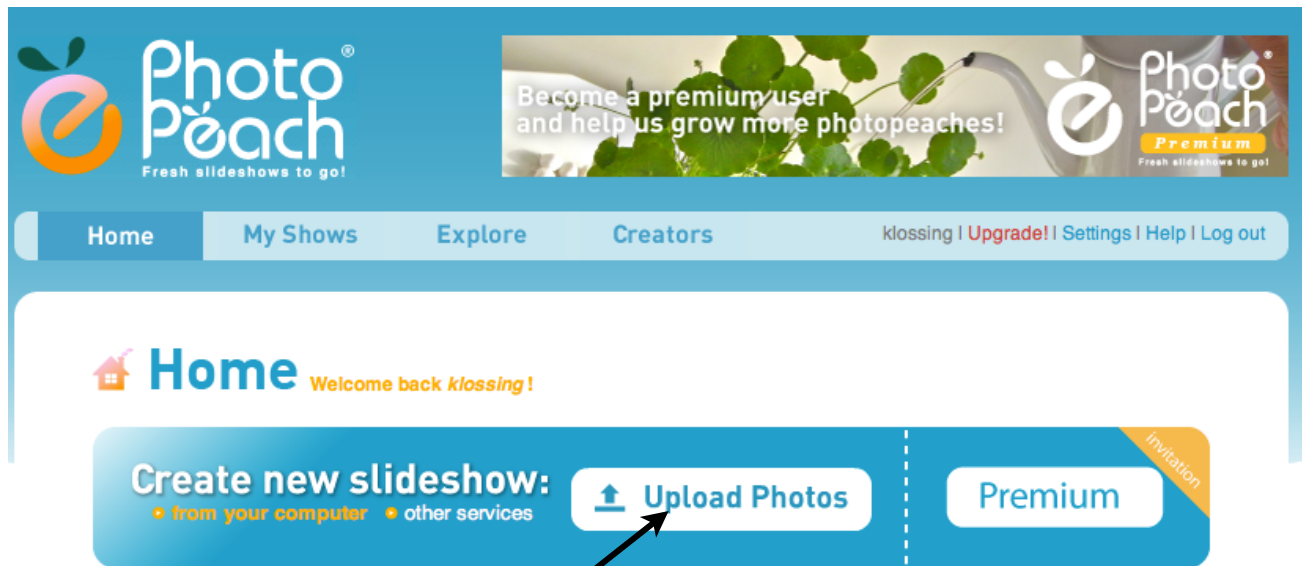


PhotoPeach

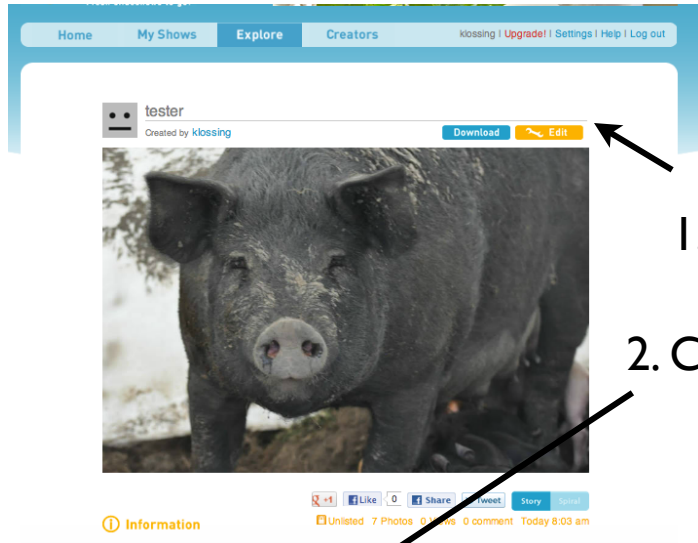
Prev Finish

Click Finish when done.

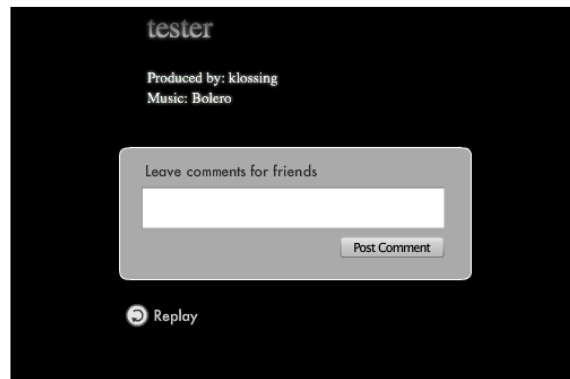
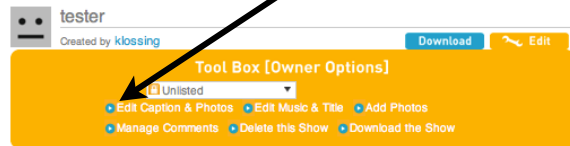
Adding the Text



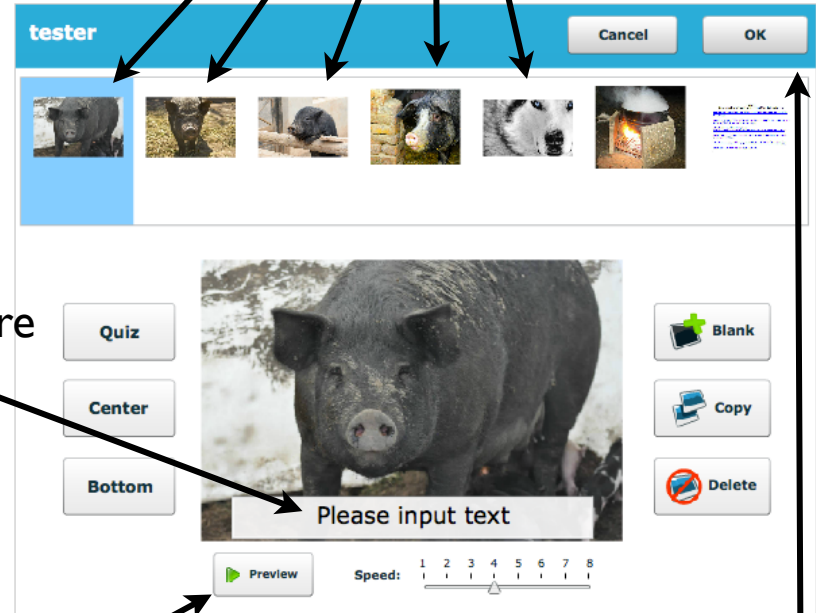
1. Click Edit
